

Project management:

is the discipline of planning, organizing, motivating, and controlling resources to achieve specific goals


ELEMENTS OF PROJECT MANAGEMENT:

PROJECT MANAGEMENT IS PROJECT DELIVERY




COMMON FACTORS IN PROJECT MANAGEMENT....

Regardless of the Contracting model for delivery of the project, good Project Management must have the following:

- The Plan....clear goal and vision for the project
- **Schedule** for delivery
- Materials, equipment and logistics
- Key <u>Personnel</u>
- Funding and political support

The three components of any Project, which must be balanced for success.

- Cost
- Quality
- Time

Quality

Time



LETS LOOK AT -- COST

What happens when Cost is the most important factor in managing the project...

- Can lead to reduced quality
- Can lead to scheduling problems

WHEN PROJECTS ARE CONSTRAINED BY COST

A project near Mt. St. Helens was designed with an inadequate budget:

- Specifications [quality] were compromised, increasing the risk of roadway failure
- Time was impacted when the Contract had to be extended due to failures in the newly constructed roadway.

SLOPE FAILURE




RESULTS IN ROADWAY SETTLEMENT & PAVEMENT FAILURE



AND WHAT ABOUT QUALITY?

When Quality is out of balance.....

- Can lead to costs increases and overruns for a higher quality....but do you need a Cadillac to get you to work?
- Can lead to increases in time to obtain the higher quality



GRAND TETONS EAST SIDE HIGHWAY

Quality was primary in the reconstruction of the highway.

- Production of crushed material was more expensive
- Longer production time

AND THEN THERE IS TIME

- When time is critical, cost and quality may suffer....
 - Can lead to accelerated efforts, overtime, etc which cost more, and
 - Can lead to quality loss in order to meet the schedule.
